## Lake Levels Rise

This 'Wet Season' has brought plenty of rain to the Kimberley. The Argyle Lake level continues to rise, ensuring loads of fresh water for our 2021 teams. To all our ocean swimmers coming to the Kimberley, remember to get an open water swim in fresh water if you can (fresh water is less buoyant than salt water).

Remember, anticipate water temperatures around 27 degrees in Lake Argyle, so strictly no wet-suits, to ensure no-one overheats. Fresh, warm water and no sharks – bring on the 2021 Swim!
